Local NACC Groups in Norfolk, Suffolk and Cambridgeshire are working together with IBD professionals from our region's hospitals to hold a Family Fun Day at Banham Zoo.

This fabulous day is open to young persons diagnosed with Crohn's Disease or Ulcerative Colitis together with their parents or carers, brothers and sisters. Numbers will be limited and allocated on a first-come first reserved basis. To qualify, at least one young person in your party must have IBD.

There will be opportunities to tour the Zoo with a keeper, experience the Birds of Prey display and meet other families. There will also be specialist presentations and Q&A sessions given by IBD consultants and nurses from our local area.

The cost of the day, including entrance to the Zoo, will be confirmed shortly but is expected to be less than £15.00 per adult. All children under 15 will be admitted free thanks to the generous support of Banham Zoo. Food will be available for purchase from the Zoo's café facilities or, if you prefer, you may bring your own picnic.

The day will begin with registration at about 10.00am and full details of times and sessions will be provided on the booking forms in the near future. A full day is being planned but there will be plenty of time at the end of the day for families to stay on and enjoy the facilities of the Zoo at their leisure until closing time.
